### THE DEEP END • Glimpses of Heaven

At various points in the Gospels, we are treated to a brief glimpse of heaven – the baptism of Jesus by John, when the heavens open and God’s voice is heard; the Transfiguration where Jesus is transformed in the presence of Peter, James and John; and the Ascension, when Jesus is lifted up into heaven before the disciples’ very eyes. There are times when we get the sense that we have been treated to a glimpse of heaven – like when we are moved by a ‘heavenly’ experience, piece of music, sunset or breathtaking scenery. But today’s feast of the Ascension reminds us that where Jesus has gone, we hope to follow. Elsewhere He tells us that He is going to prepare a place for us. We cannot imagine what lies in store in the life everlasting, the life beyond this life, which we hope to share with God. We can only see a reflection in this world of the splendour and beauty that awaits: ‘The world is charged with the grandeur of God’ (Gerard Manley Hopkins).

‘Oh, I have slipped the surly bonds of earth, And danced the skies on laughter-silvered wings; Sunward, I’ve climbed, and joined the tumbling mirth of sun-split clouds...and done a hundred things you have not dreamed of...Wheeled and soared and swung high in the sunlit silence... 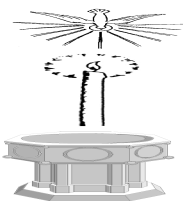
