

This Palm Sunday with the Church throughout the world we begin the celebration of Holy Week. The ceremonies of these days are rich in beauty, symbolism and prayer and we look forward to each part of this year's celebration. On Wednesday 8th April our Parish Celebration of Reconciliation is at 7.30pm (visiting priests will be present). A number of our liturgies over these days have been prepared with children in mind. Our celebration of The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday will be celebrated at 7.30pm. We have prepared a very special celebration this year and we especially look forward to welcoming the children and young people of the parish to this year's Holy Thursday liturgy. (N.B. There will no 5pm celebration of mass this year). On Good Friday the children's celebration of the Stations of the Cross is prayed at 12 noon with the help of the 5th class pupils from Scoil Aine. On Easter Sunday we celebrate a special Easter Sunday Morning Mass for Families at 10am. We invite all the children to bring a flower to carry in the entrance procession and then to place it in the Easter Garden at the beginning of Mass. We do hope you and your family will be able to join in each part of year's celebration of Easter as together we celebrate the death and resurrection of Christ our Saviour. Full details of these and of all the ceremonies are posted in the church porches.

We wish all our parishioners, all who worship in this parish church and all our visitors a most Blessed and Holy Easter.
