In his beautiful poem, An Chéad Aoine ('The First Friday'), Seán Ó Leocháin reflects on the monthly ritual of the local priest bringing 'the food of life' to the poet's father. What strikes him most, however, is not the ritual itself, but the manner in which Christ arrives: 'ach Críost a theacht I gearr athláimhe a cheannaigh an sagart ó fhear I Ros Comáin ('that Christ would come in a second hand car that the priest had bought from a man in Roscommon'). Isn't it so often the case that Christ, comes, in that other poet Patrick Kavanagh's words, 'where life pours ordinary plenty'?
