A new roster for **Ministers of the Eucharist** is available for collection in the Sacristy.

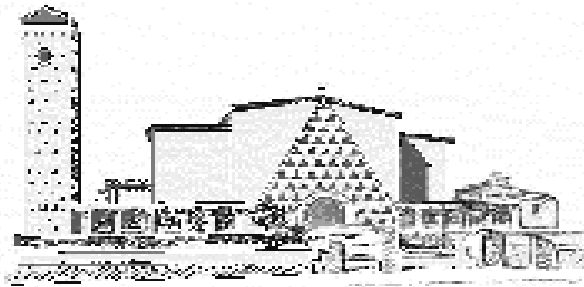
