I am writing to you to tell you that St. Anne's Conference, celebrates its 50th birthday on Monday 5th December. On 5th December 1966, the papers formally setting up the Conference were signed in the International Headquarters of the society in Paris.

On my own and the Conference's behalf, I want to thank each and every one of you, our much appreciated benefactors and friends, for your continuing generosity and support over all of the years since 1966. We also thank our retired members and volunteers for their sterling contributions over the half century, and we also acknowledge the great generosity of all who helped us in any way, and who are no longer with us.

In the earliest days of the Church, all those thousands of years ago, people gave what they could to the Apostles to help the poor (see Acts of the Apostles, Ch.4:32-37).
